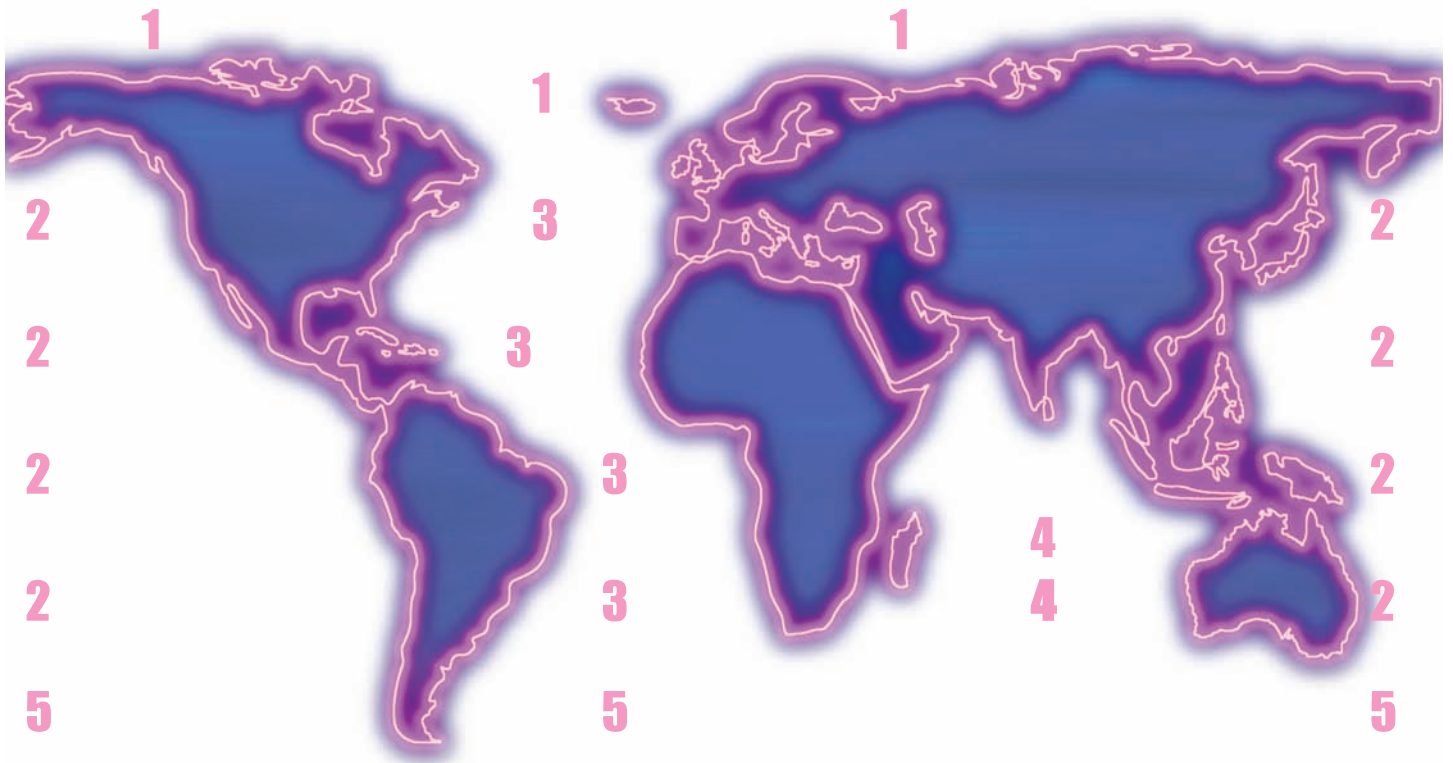


THE OCEANS SPEAKER'S NOTES



Here are some sentences to be read aloud to the listener. The words in **RED** are missing from the sheet. The listener's task is to fill in the missing words. Read the sentences clearly, but not too slowly or loudly. After the listener has filled in the missing word(s) in a sentence, say whether the answer is correct.

The world has **FIVE** oceans.

The biggest is the **PACIFIC** Ocean, which is number **TWO** on the map. The **PACIFIC** is between North America and **ASIA**, and **SOUTH AMERICA** and **AUSTRALIA**.

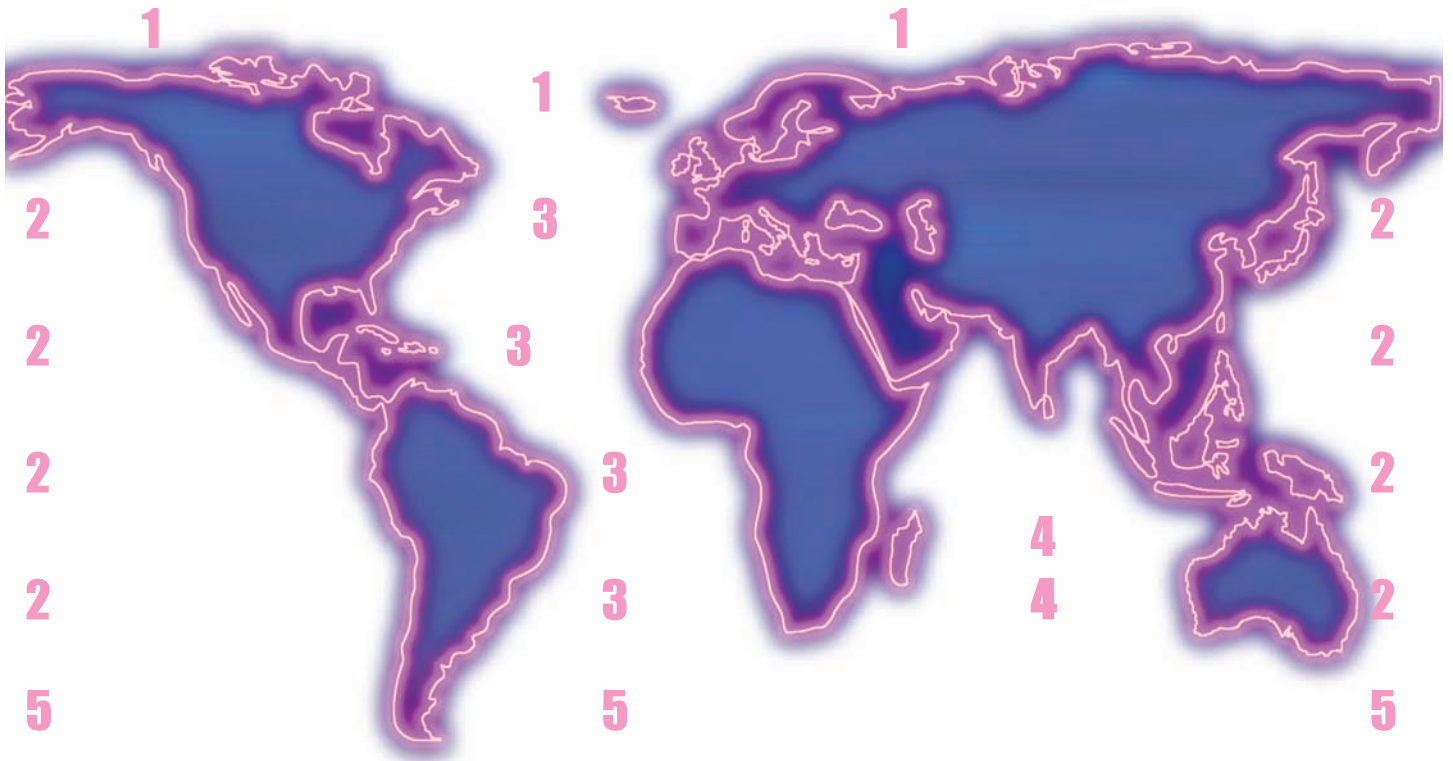
The **INDIAN OCEAN** lies to the south of **ASIA** between **AFRICA** and **AUSTRALIA**. It's number **FOUR** on the map.

The ocean between **NORTH AMERICA** and **EUROPE** is the **ATLANTIC OCEAN**. It's also between **SOUTH AMERICA** and **AFRICA**. It's number **THREE** on the **MAP**.

Number **ONE** on the map is the **ARCTIC OCEAN**. It's to the north of **NORTH AMERICA**, **EUROPE**, and **ASIA**.

The fifth ocean is below **SOUTH AMERICA**, **AFRICA**, and **AUSTRALIA**. This is the **SOUTHERN OCEAN**, which is number **FIVE** on the **MAP**. It's sometimes called **THE GREAT SOUTHERN OCEAN** or **THE ANTARCTIC OCEAN**.
